Is the center a referral center for a disorder/operation: Yes. We are accredited by the French government as the national coordinating centre for Rare Urinary Tract malformations (MARVU).and also accredited as national referral center for Endocrine rare development disorders (DSD). We are center for pediatric renal transplantation and also a platform for minimal invasive and robotic surgery. Our hospital is a mother child hospital and we are serving a population of greater Paris area (12 millions) and referral cases from other french regions, Europe and overseas.
