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Does the center have an EBPU certified training program: No

Is the center a referral center for a disorder/operation: Yes. We serve over 8 million+ population in Ontario and draw specialty patients from across Canada, the USA, and overseas. We engage in the full depth of paediatric urology care including complex hypospadias, reconstruction, endourology, laparascopy, oncology, management of differences in sexual development, congenital anomalies, upper and lower urinary tract conditions, prenatal urology assessments, and pediatric renal transplantation.

We also perform basic, clinical, and translational research. We engage in robust Telehealth services (Canada is the third largest geographic nation on earth) and have strong ties with the adult Urology programs as part of the University of Toronto Urology Residency Training Programme. Sickkids trains 4-5 fellows per year at any time. We are the only programme outside the USA accredited to qualify U.S. trainees to write the Certificate of Added Qualification examination in Pediatric Urology. We were also recently accredited for a new Area of Focused Competency Certificate in Pediatric Urology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Sickkids is exploring full accreditation status with the EBPU.

At what time of year and how long a fellow shall visit the center: Best is in the Fall, Winter, or Spring months (Sept/Oct to April/May) . New North American trainees all begin in the summer months (July/August).

A visit for 2 weeks minimum will provide a good integrated exposure to all of the operating and ambulatory activities, including teaching conferences. (International licensing and credentialing requirements in Ontario make short-term attending on patients challenging).

How active can the visiting fellow be (either due to legislations or institutional circumstances): Only Observer

Scheduled educative activities visiting fellow can attend: Weekly pediatric urology teaching conferences (Fridays), and monthly journal clubs, University and Hospital Surgical and Urological Grand rounds, morbidity & mortality rounds. A vast array of hospital and university conferences are also available to attend. All activities are conducted in English.

Is there a possibility some of these activities can be done in English: Yes

Cost of living in Euros for a month (including accommodation and transport considering a moderate lifestyle): 2600

Is there any facility for easy/cheap accommodation: Yes.
