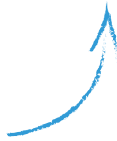

2024 ESPU Honorary Member

Emilio Merlini

He was born in Genoa in December 1950 and graduated in Medicine at the local State University. After two years of residency in General Surgery he dedicated himself to Paediatric Surgery and Paediatric Urology and completed training in both paediatric surgery and general urology.



He worked as Assistant and, later as Deputy Director in the Department of Paediatric Surgery and Urology at the Children's Hospital in Alessandria, Italy, from 1978 to 2000.

From 2001 to 2008 Dr. Merlini has served as Director of the Division of Paediatric Surgery in "Maggiore della Carità" University Hospital in Novara, Italy.

From January 2008 to December 2017 he directed the Division of Paediatric Urology, Regina Margherita Children's Hospital, Turin, Italy.

At the present time he works as Honorary Consultant Paediatric Urologist in Children's Hospital, Alessandria Italy.

Dr. Merlini served as SHO in Paediatric Urology in Alder Hey Children's Hospital, Liverpool, under Mr. Herbert Johnston, later in 1993 as Senior Registrar to Mr. Philip Ransley in Great Ormond Street Hospital for Sick Children in London and Locum Consultant in Addenbrooke's and in Guy's Hospital.

Dr. Merlini has participated as volunteer to several surgical missions in low income Countries.

Dr. Merlini has been President of the Italian Society of Pediatric Urology, member of the Educational Committee of ESPU, from 2008 Board Member and from 2010 to 2016 Treasurer of the ESPU.

He served as the President of the ESPU from 2021 to 2023.

Dr. Merlini has authored several papers and chapters of books on arguments of Paediatric Urology and general Paediatric Surgery, and is the reviewer of the Journal of Urology and Assistant editor of the Journal of Paediatric Urology.

2024 ESPU Honorary Member

Gianantonio Manzoni

He was born in Milan in 1953 and is married and has three children.



After completing his medical studies in Milan, he trained in both Paediatric Surgery and Urology. From 1982 to 1985, he specialized in Paediatric Urology and was trained at GOS Hospital for Sick Children in London under Philip G. Ransley.

Returning to Italy, he served as head of the Section of Paediatric Urology at Ospedale di Circolo in Varese from 1991 to 2009, and later as head of the Department of Paediatric Urology at Fondazione IRCCS Cà Granda Ospedale Maggiore Policlinico in Milan.

He has held key roles with the ESPU, serving as the third Secretary (1999–2003) and later as President (2014–2016).

His interests include prenatally diagnosed uropathies, complex genital reconstruction, and pioneering paediatric robotic urology in Italy. He has been invited as a Visiting Professor at various institutions and has conducted numerous humanitarian surgical missions in low-income countries such as SIUT Pakistan, Albania, and Romania.

He is currently happily enjoying his retirement with his family in Milan.

John Duckett Lecture

Each year ESPU board decides on a Lecturer for the Duckett Lecture named after the famous Paediatric Urologist John Duckett to recognize his contribution to increasing the collaboration between two continents in the field of Paediatric Urology. Traditionally an American and a European give the lecture in alternate years.
